Since joining the Danna McKitrick, David has drafted several bills which have subsequently been enacted as state statutes including the Missouri Religious Freedom Restoration Act and a law permitting social service agencies to act as guardians for disabled individuals.

David received the Albert "Red" Villa Human Rights Award from the St. Louis Civil Rights Commission in 1992 and the Jurisprudence Award from the Anti-Defamation League in 1994.
