**Great Rivers Environmental Law Center Will Present
Lewis C. Green Environmental Service Awards to
Ron Coleman and Terry Cunningham**

On Sunday, September 23, 2012, Great Rivers Environmental Law Center will present its Lewis C. Green Environmental Service Awards to Ron Coleman and Terry Cunningham. Ron Coleman is the Executive Director of the Open Space Council and Terry Cunningham is the Forest Manager of Pioneer Forest in the Missouri Ozarks. Great Rivers presents this award annually to individuals who have shown long-time commitment to the preservation of the environment.

The Great Rivers' board of directors selected Ron Coleman because for decades he has been an outspoken advocate for conservation of parks and open space. The Board selected Terry Cunningham because for decades he has been a national leader of sustainable forestry.

Great Rivers will honor Mr. Coleman and Mr. Cunningham at a party at the home of Tom and Lisa Carnahan on September 23, 2012. The event is open to the public; tickets are \$125 and may be purchased by contacting Great Rivers.

The award is named after the founder of Great Rivers Environmental Law Center, the late Lewis C. Green, a leading environmental litigator in Missouri for many decades.
