**Great Rivers Environmental Law Center Presents  
Lewis C. Green Environmental Service Awards to  
Senator Joan Bray and Don Corrigan**

On Thursday, November 4, 2010, Great Rivers Environmental Law Center presented Lewis C. Green Environmental Service Awards to Senator Joan Bray and Don Corrigan, Editor of the Webster-Kirkwood Times and Professor of Journalism at Webster University. Great Rivers presents two awards annually to individuals who have shown long-time commitment to the preservation of the environment.

The board selected Senator Bray for her eighteen years of work in the Missouri General Assembly, where she was a leading advocate of laws designed to preserve and protect the environment and public health. She strongly supported improved public transportation, serving on local, state and national passenger rail committees and the Governor's Total Transportation Commission. The board selected Don Corrigan because he has reported extensively on environmental issues ranging from transport of hazardous wastes to dioxin contamination at Times Beach, Mo. In addition, at Webster University, Mr. Corrigan recently started a Certificate in Outdoor/Environmental Journalism program in which students learn to communicate about outdoor and environmental issues.

Florence Shinkle, co-author of "*A Force for Nature: the Environmental Litigation of Lewis C. Green*," spoke at the Awards Dinner which was held at the St. Louis Woman's Club.

The awards are named after the founder of Great Rivers Environmental Law Center, the late Lewis C. Green, a leading environmental litigator in Missouri for many decades.
